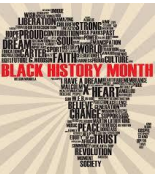

Pastor's Corner

Becoming the Church that gives Glory to God

His letter to Ephesians develops these themes in details, calling all believers to the stewardship/dispensing God's riches of Love and Grace.

Spirit of Prophecy says this about the church at its best: *"Christ designs that heaven's order, heaven's plan of government, heaven's divine harmony, shall be represented in His church on earth. 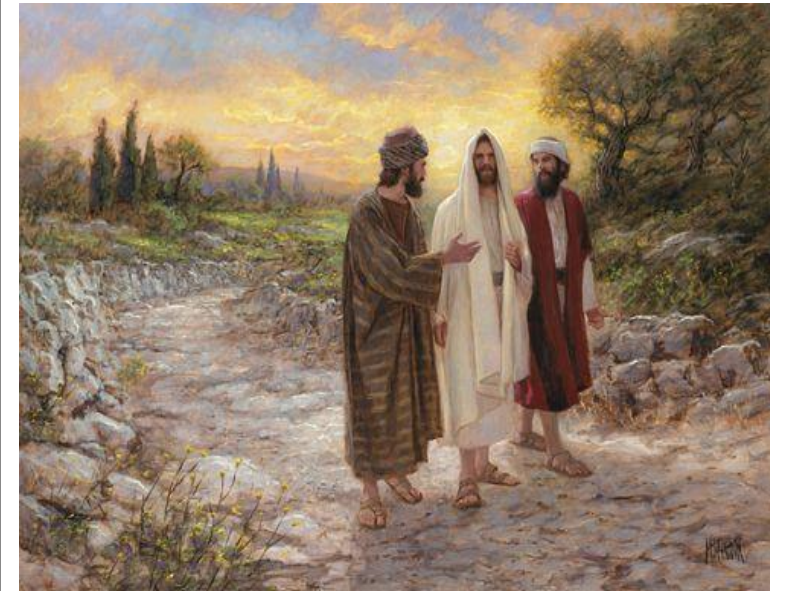
Please consider these 10 Habits of a Mission-driven Church that we need to embrace as we grow our culture:

5. Envisioning Mission – knowing what and why we do (Prov.28:19)
6. Strategy in Writing – making clear How we work (Matthew 4:4)
7. Aligning Departments – prioritizing & pruning (Luke 14:28)
8. Accomplishing Mission – collaborating in the work! (Psalm 126:6)
9. Assessing Impact – keeping updated scoreboard (Matthew 25:23)
10. Modeling – shining the light of excellence (Matthew 5:16)

If we do the church the way God's Word says, the Lord has promised to make us the "head and not the tail." If we listen to the Biblical advice we will "always be on top and never on the bottom" (Deuteronomy 28:13) I invite you to make a commitment that, empowered by the Holy Spirit, would learn these Habits, and make them enduring Values to shape our Culture, our new DNA, returning to the Apostolic Discipleship Church.
