Pastor's Corner – Starting the Year with Prayer and Kindness

It is always good to pray. And as we enter into 2020 we are already frightened with prospects of war, and economic problems looming. An initiative of 10-days of prayer started on January 8, today, as I write this blog, inviting Adventists all around the world to pray, culminating on Sabbath, January 18. The materials and resources are available online. www.tendaysofprayer.org.

This year all prayers are focused on seeking God's Spirit. And it must be our personal desire to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Yet the best prayers are when we ask God to open our eyes that we may see people we ought to pray for. Ask God to show you seven people to pray for during these ten days. These may be family members, friends, coworkers, church members, etc. Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead these seven people to abide in Christ. Ask God to show you how you can pray for specific needs and reach out to your seven people during this time.

Next Sabbath, January 18 as I will lead in Windsor and Pastor Ndlovu @ Living Faith, we will ask for testimonies of answered prayers. When we hear people ask for specific things it is OK to repeat their requests as it shows our agreement. Saying "Amen" is already agreeing and reflecting on heard prayers just takes the agreement to a higher level. When someone prays a request to God, be sure some others pray for that same request and agree together! Don't think that because one person has prayed about the request, no one else needs to. "Again I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching anything that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven" (Matthew 18:19).

As you join in Ten Days of Prayer to consider some type of fasting, such as fasting from TV, secular music, movies, the Internet, sweets, or other types of food that are hard to digest. Use the extra time to pray and study the Bible, asking God to help you and our congregation to abide more fully in Christ. By adopting a simple diet, we allow our minds to become more receptive to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

In The Ministry of Healing we read, "We must live a twofold life—a life of thought and action, of silent prayer and earnest work" (p. 512). It is our privilege to show others the love of Jesus. We have received so much love from our Savior; let's not keep it for ourselves. Let's share His love with others. So let's challenge ourselves to do acts of kindness during this time of prayer and fasting.

Choose a day and be the hands and feet of Jesus. Cook a meal for someone who has been sick. Give food to a homeless person. Donate clothing that you would want donated to you. "Adopt" an elderly person. Visit the person on a regular basis and help with chores, shopping, cooking, or garden work. Bake some bread and share a loaf with a neighbor. Offer to stay with a sick or disabled person so their caretakers can run an errand. Introduce yourself to a new neighbor by taking them a meal. Make them feel welcome in the neighborhood. Buy groceries and deliver them to a needy family. Donate your old eyeglasses. Offer to give a Bible study. Visit people in nursing homes. Give some "food" money to a student. The list of acts of kindness is inexhaustible. Just Do It!
