Pastor's Corner

Facing Viruses, Pandemic with Faith & Love

For the past two months has been the longest duration of media focusing on the viral pandemic spreading from China around the world, and with every day there is more negative consequences. The talk is about cancelling the Olympic games, Euro Football (UEFA), even the upcoming General Conference session, as the fear of restrictions on travel grows. In many countries worship places are closed, public gatherings for church services are cancelled for fear of contamination and contagion. Before this virus breakout the fears were about the coming Sunday Law and persecution that may come against those worshipping on Sabbath, not many imagined that a virus would stop worship, and close churches, worse than persecution. I am thinking of the passage in Hebrews 10:39 "we're not quitters who lose out. Oh, no! We'll stay with it and survive, trusting all the way."

Let me put it in the context – Paul is talking about the soon coming of Christ, and the great struggle that comes before, suffering and tribulation. And then he offers this advice: Therefore do not cast away your confidence, which has great reward. For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise: "For yet a little while, and He who is coming will come and will not tarry. Now the just shall live by faith; but if anyone draws back, my soul has no pleasure in him." But we are not of those who draw back to destruction, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul. (Hebrews 10:35-39)

The righteous live by faith, not allowing anxiety and worry to ruin our spirit and be destroyed. Have faith and keep your soul and spirit in peace, the peace that is above understanding that does not even make sense. And the soul-health and spirit-well-being are essential for physical health. 3rd letter of John verse 2 tells us that our prosperity and health is matching our soul health. Our attitude, our tune of the spirit is the door-gate to our physical health. Pray, stay connected to God in personal devotions, and trust God's provisions in your life for everything. God is in control. God knows what is permitted. And do not confuse this pandemic with plagues, as some speculate. The plagues of Revelation are poured on the wicked, on the beastly powers, on the throne of evil, and it takes place after the door of probation closes, and there is no more repentance, not more change, no more turning around.

Do follow hygienic precautions, do not sneeze on others, abstain from unnecessary embraces, but also live with compassion and care for others. Christian love was manifested in the worst outbreaks of epidemics in history. When everyone turned away, Christians ministered to the sick and dying, without fear, knowing that their reward is eternal, without fear of temporary sleep. Pray for this epidemic to stop that the work of love may continue, and fear not, for our God is Jehovah Rapha, Healing God!
